Parent Governor Outcome

At the start of the recruitment process we had two Parent Governor vacancies to fill. Following the first round of recruitment we were able to fill one of the two roles. Following the advertisement to find a suitable candidate for the second role we had three applicants. As there were now more applicants than positions available we held a parent/carer ballot. I am writing to inform you of the result of our election for Parent Governor following the parent/carer ballot which closed on Thursday 14th December 2023. There was one Parent Governor vacancy. Thank you to all parents/carers who took the time to vote in the election.

The results were very close for all three candidates, however, I am pleased to let you know that following the ballot, Mrs Sharon Wood, was elected as Parent Governor at Priory Community School.

On behalf of the Chair of the Academy Council, the Governors and the Principal, I would like to thank all the great candidates who put their names forward for this role.

Car Park Safety

With the weather turning the car park is becoming increasingly busy. I would like to ask for your support with this matter, please don't drive into school during the mornings and afternoons unless it is absolutely necessary. **Vehicle access should be for taxi services and the school bus only.** The car park within Sainsbury's is a very convenient place for you to drop your child as it is a very short distance from the school and can be accessed safely via the underpass or pedestrian crossing.

We want to create a safe environment for all our students, whether cycling or walking to school, and the amount of cars in the morning and afternoon are making this difficult.

Staff on duty will of course move vehicles along who are parking/waiting in unsafe positions whether that be parents/carers or taxis.

Similarly, if you are picking up or dropping off your child in the mornings via Wansbrough Road, please ensure you are not stopping local residents from entering or exiting their roads or driveways. The yellow markings on Wansbrough Road are also not an area to be used for picking up or dropping off your children.

Although you may only stop for a brief moment, when lots of cars are doing this at the same time it can cause issues for many members of the local community. We appreciate your cooperation on this.
