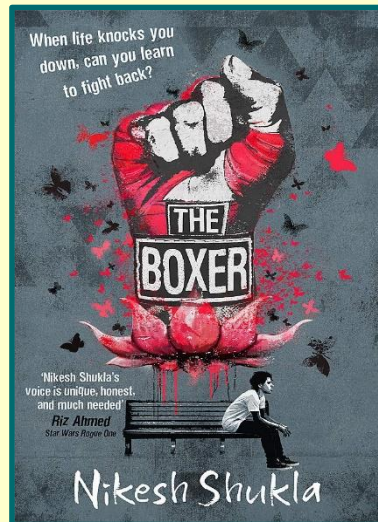


*“She stopped on the second to last picture.

Book 2: The Boxer by Nikesh Shukla

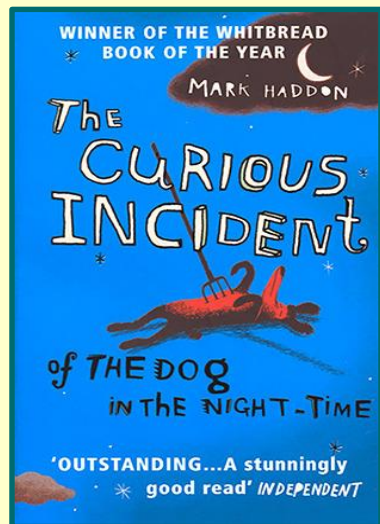


*“What are you scared of?” Shobu asks.
